SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

Following instructions should be observed for your and others safety. Severe injury or fatal accidents could incur if these instructions are ignored.

- 1. Only trained operators should handle machines and this sawblade.
- Ensure that the sawblade contained within the package is free from defects such as chipping, tooth breakage, cracks, warping and excessive wear and tear. If the sawblade has any of these defects do not use it.
- 3. Sawblades with cracks in body shall be scrapped (repairing is not permitted).
- 4. Power off the machine before changing the sawblade.
- 5. Install the sawblade without chipping the cutting edges. Make sure that flanges are clean from debris and that the sawblade is fitted according to machine suppliers' instructions.
- 6. Direction of revolution and the sawblade cutting direction should be the same.
- 7. Safety covers on machines must be in place and proper working clothes must be worn by operators, such as shoes, goggles and helmets. Follow the safety regulations specified in your country.

Before start using the sawblade read the instruction manual carefully and understand it fully. Please contact your nearest Micor distributor or directly to Micor head office if there is anything not understood or if you have any questions about how to use this sawblade.
